About the role

Our <u>Online Support Forum</u> is an online community, where people living with or affected by diabetes can get valuable peer support, find information and share their experiences.

Hosts welcome new members to help them feel supported and use their own experiences of diabetes to offer helpful responses, making a difference to a large network of people living with diabetes. By sharing knowledge, members get a broader understanding of their diabetes. Hosts have the option to offer general support or focus on a <u>topic</u> they may have experience in, for example 'Pregnancy or 'Pumps.'
